Event Highlights

1. An opening ceremony attended by 800 distinguished guests, including religious leaders, leading Muslim business figures in Thailand, and commercial attachés.
2. Collaboration with the Ministry of Industry and the Board of Investment (BOI) to invite investors from the Middle East and South Asia to invest in Thailand's Halal Economic Zones.
3. The Future Food Zone, accompanied by seminars organized by the National Food Institute (NFI) and the National Innovation Agency (NIA).
4. Dedicated Halal Logistics Zone and seminar programs addressing supply chain and logistics solutions.
5. Tourism promotion activities organized by the Saudi Ministry of Tourism, including Hajj and Umrah travel.
6. A dedicated zone and activities jointly organized with the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) to promote Muslim-Friendly Travel.
7. Collaboration with the Southern Border Provinces Administrative Centre (SBPAC) and the Thailand Textile Institute (THTI) to support entrepreneurs and cooperatives in Thailand's three southern border provinces. It focuses on the development of gifts, premium products, textiles, apparel, and uniform products, with marketing and distribution support, including financial assistance from Thai government banks.
8. In cooperation with the Bangkok Islamic International College, Krirk University, an International Islamic Academic Conference 2026 will be organized, with participation from members of the Federation of International Islamic Universities.
9. The Halal Clinic Zone and Halal Solutions Zone, organized in collaboration with the Central Islamic Council of Thailand (CICOT) and leading universities.
10. Muslim cultural activities jointly organized with the Ministry of Culture.
11. A national meeting of Islamic cooperative members from across Thailand.
12. Organized in collaboration with the Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA).
13. A Health & Wellness Zone and seminar program, jointly organized with the Ministry of Public Health.

Visitor Attendance

- An estimated 12,000–15,000 business visitors from more than 50 countries are expected to attend.
- The Central Islamic Council of Thailand (CICOT), in cooperation with its MRA partners, will invite no fewer than 300 key buyers from the Middle East and North Africa, with hotel accommodation support provided.
- In addition, more than 200 key buyers from South Asia and Southeast Asia will be invited under sponsored buyer programs.
